FROM THE RABBI

Mishenichnas Adar Marbim B'Simcha

The above expression, contained in the Shulchan Aruch, the Code of Jewish Law, instructs us that our joy should increase with the arrival of the month of Adar. We are also told that Adar is a fortuitous month to have a court case, if indeed that is necessary.

Adar is the month that came up in the lottery when the evil Haman was deciding when to destroy the Jewish people. He thought this would be a good month for such an action. Moses, our greatest prophet, died during this month. He failed to realize, however, that Moses was also born in Adar.

When news of Haman's decree became known to the Jews, they fasted and repented for their sins. Esther risked her life to approach the king. In the end, Haman's plan was turned upside down. Haman was hanged on the gallows built for Mordechai. Haman's sons as well met a similar fate. The Jewish people fought back against the Persians and survived. Thus began the celebration of Purim.

As we approach Adar this year we have seen an assortment of troubling circumstances for our people and our homeland. Let us all take this opportunity to look back and reflect. We must also remember that Hashem is always there for us, no matter how bleak circumstances may sometimes appear. May the absolute knowledge of Hashem's guidance bring us to the joy spoken of in the Shulchan Aruch, and may this Adar bring us closer to redemption.


