Minyan Is a Team Sport

Every weekday morning at 6:45 a.m. and every weekday evening at 6:00 p.m. we gather together at Congregation Etz Chayim to have services. Public prayer has been part of the Jewish lexicon for thousands of years. The tradition continues in Toledo with the daily minyan.

The Rabbis established that a quorum for minyan is ten Jewish males above the age of thirteen. Nine of the greatest Torah scholars cannot say Kaddish or Borchu until one more eligible person arrives. It is incumbent upon every synagogue to provide a minyan for its members who need or desire one.

I take this opportunity to give a personal thank you to our president, Dan Becker. First of all, he sets the example by participating in minyan many times each week. Additionally, he begins his report at every board meeting stressing the importance of attending services.

As you are probably aware, our numbers at Etz Chayim continue to dwindle. With that, the pool from which to draw minyan participants keeps shrinking. The importance of everyone's involvement is becoming even more magnified.

I am asking all of you to join the team. I won't promise you a uniform (Does tallis and tefillin count?), but I can guarantee you the reward of knowing you have been part of a synagogue's greatest responsibility. Our minyan is on the map. Let it never be so that a visitor came to our shul and couldn't find a minyan.

Tisha B'Av 5775 is observed this year on July 25-26, 2015.

Tisha B'Av (lit. "ninth of Av"); is a day of fasting and mourning on the ninth of Av commemorating the Destruction of the first and the second Holy Temples.

Tisha B'Av, commemorates a list of catastrophes so severe it's clearly a day specially cursed by G d. Some say this is another confirmation of our deeply held conviction that history isn't haphazard.
