FROM THE RABBI

Mashiv HaRuach is Not a Prayer for Rain

On Shemini Atzeret as part of the Musaf service we begin saying Mashiv HaRuach as part of the Amidah. In the second blessing we declare that Hashem causes the wind to blow and the rain to fall. That statement however is, in no way, a prayer asking for rain.

Mashiv HaRuach is a statement contained within the blessing of Shemonah Esrei which speaks of Hashem's powers. It speaks of many things, including reviving the dead and healing the sick. Between Shemini Atzeret and Pesach we add a statement about rain.

Requests are found in the middle section of the Amidah, blessings four through sixteen. Within that section we ask Hashem to fulfill all of our needs. This list includes such things as intelligence, forgiveness, and healing. In the ninth blessing, referred to as the blessing of the seasons, we add a request for rain beginning on the night of December 4th, one of the few things determined by the solar calendar.

Despite the fact that Mashiv HaRuach is not a request, we only say it during the rainy season. The Rabbis felt that it was not appropriate to even refer to the power to make rain if rain was not desired at the time. After all, Hashem always fulfills requests.

May this rainy season be good for us and our brethren in Israel.

The Indian chief remained speechless for several minutes. His response showed wisdom and was simple. He looked at the two boys and responded, "Young ones, the fate of this bird lies solely in your hands." Similarly, the fate of our synagogue is not solely in my hands. Rather, it is in our collective grip, all of our congregants. And it is through our combined efforts that we strive to meet our needs, confronting real challenges, maintaining and building on our strengths, celebrating our vibrancy, and being the Etz Chayim family of which we all feel so much a part. I look to each of you for your support in the coming year. I thank you for confidence, and equally, your understanding, that the future of Etz Chayim lies *collectively* in all of our hands. 
The book is the companion piece to the Ken Burns PBS documentary film based on their experiences.

Meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held regularly on the fourth Thursday evening of the months of April, May, June, July, August, September and October and the fourth Sunday morning of the months of November, December, January, February and March, unless such meeting day occurs on a Jewish or legal holiday, or interferes with a city-wide communal function. In the latter instances, the President shall designate a substitute date for the meeting, as close as possible to the regular meeting date.

This is to be voted on at the January, 2017 Board Meeting.
