FROM THE RABBI

HAPPY SECULAR NEW YEAR?



Time and again I am asked what if any meaning January 1st has for me. It certainly has no significance as a religious day, and other than a later morning minyan and college football, has little other relevance. The solar year, however, does play a role in the Jewish calendar.

The Jewish calendar is essentially lunar. As our months are determined by the cycle of the moon, with a new month happening at every new moon. We do, however, have some solar components to our year. Passover must be in the spring and Sukkot in the fall. Seasons are dictated by the solar calendar, and this causes leap years in the Jewish calendar. Additionally, the prayer for rain which we add in the Amidah is only said during the rainy season, something else based on the solar calendar.

If I happen to be awake at midnight on December 31st, I will watch the ball drop and acknowledge the turning of the page toward 2017. I will definitely enjoy the later services in the morning and the wealth of sports programming. I know that while not my main calendar, the solar year dictates many aspects of Jewish life. For this reason I take note when I need to start writing different numbers on my checks.




Congregants' Generosity Helps Many in Need

SISTERHOOD NEWS




