So many kitchen volunteers learned the proper kashruth and the details of preparing and plating foods with a beautiful presentation. She always taught everyone who worked with her that the way food was prepared and served was a reflection of the shul.

Ruthie set a standard for each of us to follow. She loved people. She treated her family as friends and her friends as family. She lived life to its fullest.

It is only fitting that we remember Ruthie for so many reasons. She truly was not only the matriarch of Etz Chayim, but also of the Jewish community. We thank you Ruthie for being able to experience the beauty of your life. Your gift to each of us was wrapped beautifully – in a smile, with a hug and a kiss, and with that special piece of advice – please know that you have touched each of us.




## DAVID S. STONE RELIGIOUS SCHOOL
