FROM THE RABBI

CHOL HAMOED—SO WHICH IS IT?



Between the first two days of Sukkot, which are full-blown holidays, and Shemini Atzeret and Simchat Torah, which are also complete celebrations, we have five days known as Chol Hamoed, literally the weekdays of the holiday. The classic question debated is how we classify these days - are they weekdays or holidays?

The beginning and end days of Sukkot, as well as Passover, are marked by holiday celebrations, special services, unique Torah readings, and Haftarot. On Chol Hamoed the services are distinct from weekdays, but with less pomp and circumstance than

that of the holiday days. We read the Torah, but we do not have a Haftorah.

A divide in the observance of Chol Hamoed concerns work. The Rabbis encourage us to put off things that can be saved until after the holiday, but there are no specific prohibitions against work. Some have the custom to minimize work as much as possible, to maintain the integrity of the holiday. Those who do not, however, are not violating the Torah's law.

Sukkot is identified by the Torah as an eight-day celebration. Whenever possible during those eight days we need to honor the holiday. During chol hamoed we take the opportunity to have special parties, dinners, etc. Through this we help elevate the weekdays toward the level of the holiday.

I hope everyone has a wonderful and meaningful Sukkot.
