FROM THE RABBI

TU B'SHEVAT - LET'S CELEBRATE THE TREES



It always fascinates me that we have the holiday of Tu B'Shevat, which celebrates trees, at a time when in Toledo the weather is cold and snowy. The truth of the matter is, however, that there is good logic to this.

Tu B'Shevat is a new year for trees. The same way that our calendar turns on Rosh Hashanah, a tree's calendar turns on Tu B'Shevat. This is significant because we are not allowed to use anything that grows from a tree in the first three years of its life.

Those years are counted from Tu B'Shevat. If someone plants a tree now, then on Tu B'Shevat that tree will be in its second year.

The fact that a tree's new year falls in the middle of winter is fortunate. There is unlikely to be confusion when fruit grows regarding the year the tree was in at the time. Since the year changed outside of the growing season, we never encounter this problem.

Tu B'Shevat is a day which we use to celebrate our connection to Israel and to the earth. We are also reminded that no matter how much we may do toward the growing of our food, Hashem is the force making all of this possible.

Let us remember this year how fortunate we are for all that we have and all that Hashem has given us.




