On Rosh Hashanah this year I spoke about making resolutions for the new Jewish year. I hope by now those commitments are on their way to being fulfilled. I would like to take an opportunity to add one to the list. Please make a new commitment to our minyan.

Throughout the history of Congregation Etz Chayim we have maintained minyanim every morning and every evening. Currently our morning services begin at 7:30 on weekdays,

while our evening prayers start at 6:00. Times move for Shabbat based on the time of year.

As our community continues to shrink the pool of eligible minyan candidates does as well. Additionally, in the past year we have lost minyan participation from a number of staunch regulars who are no longer able to join us. As a result, obtaining a minyan, particularly in the morning, has become more difficult than any other time in the past 25 years.

Partially because of certain facts already mentioned, we certainly have those who want and need to say Kaddish. Even without that, we have a decades-old tradition in our shul. We need the participation of everyone who is available as often as possible. Only with your help can this endeavor succeed.
