# PREPARATION FOR THE HIGH HOLIDAYS



Many things we do require some sort of activity beforehand. An athlete may stretch or otherwise exercise before engaging in competition. A singer may do various things to warm up before a concert. Religious observances can be put in this category as well.

The Code of Jewish Law mentions that one should prepare an hour every day before praying to Hashem. Unfortunately, this is not achievable for most of us with our busy lives and schedules. We do make preparations, however, before Rosh Hashanah. Beginning with the first day of Elul we blow the shofar every morning except Shabbat to remind ourselves that

Rosh Hashanah is coming. We also recite Psalm 27 in the morning and evening, recognizing Hashem as the source of our salvation.

On the Saturday night before Rosh Hashanah we begin to say Selichot, special prayers of supplication. We need to say at least four days of Selichot before Rosh Hashanah, so if Rosh Hashanah falls on Monday or Tuesday, as it does this year, we begin on the Saturday night one week earlier, or about ten days before the holiday. These recitations further help to get us in the mood to celebrate the new year.

By the time we walk into the synagogue on the evening of September 29, we hopefully will be ready and excited to bring in the year 5780. May it indeed be a year in which we are all inscribed and sealed for all things good.

# Israel at Our Doorstep: Israeli Election Analysis

The Toledo Jewish community is invited to hear Israel Educator Yoni Alon discuss the results of the 2019 "snap election" held two days prior in Israel. On May 30, 2018, the Knesset voted to dissolve itself due to incumbent Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's failure to form a governing coalition, the first such failure in Israeli history. Because of the Israeli electoral system, the prime minister will not yet be known, but Alon will touch on the 120 members voted to make up the 22<sup>nd</sup> Knesset and who President Rivlin decided to invite in hopes to form a coalition. Learn which parties are in, which parties are out, how many seats each party has, and more critical results from the election. There will be a question and answer period after the analysis.

Yoni Alon is a Tel Aviv native. He served in the Israel Defense Force for seven-and-a-half years in various roles, including as a liaison officer connecting the U.S. military with the IDF.
