

FROM THE RABBI

AS ADAR COMES, OUR JOY INCREASES



We are now in the Hebrew month of Adar, the month in which Purim falls. The rabbis tell us that this is a joyous time for the Jewish people. We are encouraged to remain happy throughout the month.

Purim is strange in its observance in that we do not say Hallel, the special Psalms of praise recited on most other holidays. The rabbis offer two

explanations for this. First, they express that the reading of Megillat Esther takes the place of Hallel. Second, they offer that at the end of the story, despite the fact that we survived the decree of Haman, we are no better off than we were before. We are still subjects of the Persian kingdom.

If we really are no better off after than before, then why should we be happy? What is the source of our joy? First of all, survival is no small thing. Consider how many societies have come and gone as we have endured. Additionally, in the aftermath we gained permission to return to our land and rebuild our Beit Hamikdash.

Purim reminds us that even at our darkest hour redemption is possible. Hashem is always watching, even if He seems far away. He is there for all of us as individuals, as well as for the entire community as a whole.

A happy and healthy Purim to all.

Recipe of the Month: Pie Cake, from Barbara Feldstein.

1 ³⁄₄ c. sugar 2 c. sifted flour 1 tsp. cinnamon (2 tsp. for apple) 1 c. oil 3 eggs
1 tsp. salt
1 tsp. baking soda
1 20 oz. can of apple or cherry fruit pie filling
1 c. nuts, optional



Mix in one bowl with wooden spoon (or hands) all ingredients except fruit filling and nuts. Fold in fruit filling and nuts. Bake in 13 x 9 inch baking dish 45 to 50 minutes at 350 degrees.



Congregation Etz Chayim Cemetery Burial Policy

Effective November 1, 2018

The Congregation Etz Chayim cemeteries are Eagle Point Cemetery in Rossford, Ohio and Beth Shalom Cemetery in Oregon, Ohio. Operation of the cemeteries is governed by the rules and regulations of the Toledo Jewish Community Cemetery Association (TJCCA) and its successor(s).

The Rabbi of Congregation Etz Chayim shall have the final decision on all issues of Halacha and ritual.

Congregation Etz Chayim provides the following burial rights to members in good standing, including their minor children:

- 1. The deceased must have been an Etz Chayim member in good standing for at least the 5 years prior to death. If the deceased has not been a member for 5 years, then they must pay dues for the years they were not a member, up to the total of 5 years' dues.
- 2. The deceased must be Jewish through matrilineal lines or orthodox conversion. Non-Jewish spouses are not permitted to be buried in an Etz Chayim cemetery.
- 3. No cremations are permitted.
- 4. The casket must be a proper kosher all wood casket (to be paid to the funeral home).
- 5. Tahara, the ritual preparation of the deceased, is required to be performed by the Cheverah Kadisha. A tallis for men and a shroud are required. No jewelry or adornments are permitted.
- 6. Etz Chayim membership includes the choice of grave based on availability. Etz Chayim follows the custom of no unrelated men and women buried next to each other.
- 7. The monument (paid to a monument company) must be in compliance with TJCCA rules and regulations. The monument will be permitted to be set after all burial expenses and synagogue fees are paid in full.
- 8. Etz Chayim clergy will be available upon request to meet with family, conduct funeral and burial services, and conduct home minyans during shiva. Any substitute clergy must be approved in advance by Etz Chayim clergy.
- 9. Funeral services may be held at a funeral home (cost to be paid to funeral home), graveside, or at the chapel at Beth Shalom Cemetery.
- 10. Current burial fees are \$2700 for interment, perpetual care, and shroud (plus \$2700 prepaid interment, perpetual care, and shroud if a double monument is chosen). In addition, there is a fee of \$50 for a tallis for men if the family has not provided one, and an optional \$600 for a Memorial Plaque at Congregation Etz Chayim.
- 11. Prepayment plans are permitted and must be completed within 12 months of the first payment. All prepayments are nonrefundable and not transferable. However, if prepayment is not completed within 12 months of the first payment, all payments made through that date will be refunded.
- 12. Non-members of Etz Chayim may reserve plots in Beth Shalom Cemetery or Eagle Point Cemetery for a one-time nonrefundable fee equivalent to a one year full single or family membership in effect at the time of the reservation. This fee will not count towards the 5 years of membership required for burial.




