Sisterhood Recipe of the Month:

Triple Chocolate and Vanilla Cheesecake From Aileen Pargament



- 1 ½ cups finely crushed cream filled chocolate sandwich cookies (about 18-22 cookies)
- 3 tbs. margarine or butter, melted
- 4 8 oz. packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 14 oz. can EAGLE BRAND sweetened condensed milk not evaporated milk.
- 4 eggs
- 1/3 cup all purpose flour
- 1 tbs. vanilla extract
- 2 1 oz. square semi-sweet chocolate, melted

Heat oven to 325 degrees F. Combine crumbs and margarine, press firmly on bottom of 9" spring form pan.

In a large mixer bowl, beat cheese until fluffy.

Gradually beat in sweetened condensed milk until smooth.

Add eggs, flour and vanilla, mix well.

Divide batter in half.

Add chocolate to ½ of batter; mix well.

Pour into prepared pan.

Top evenly with vanilla batter.

Bake 50 to 55 minutes or until center springs back when lightly touched.

Cool.

Top with chocolate glaze.

Refrigerate leftovers.

Makes 12 servings.

CHOCOLATE GLAZE (*ALWAYS DOUBLE THE CHOCOLATE GLAZE*)

In small sauce pan, over low heat, melt 2 - 1 oz. squares semi-sweet chocolate with ¼ cup whipping cream. Cook and stir until thickened and smooth. Remove from heat; spread over cheesecake. (Makes about 1/3 cup.)




