



The earnings of the fund will be distributed each year among the number of approved applicants. Applications are available in the synagogue office.

The deadline for accepting applications for the summer of 2022 is March 31, 2022.

GEORGE AND EVE DAVIDSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

George and Eve Davidson, long time members of Congregation Etz Chayim, created a generous endowment for the youth of the synagogue. The fund shall be used annually to send an Etz Chayim student, or students, from families who are unable financially and economically to do so themselves, for a summer or a year in Israel to study and to learn about Judaism and the Jewish people.

Included, for consideration, will be shorter trips which otherwise meet the designated guidelines.







The Hidden Holocaust: Holocaust by Bullets

Lecture Featuring Renowned Catholic Priest Father Patrick Desbois Sunday, April 3, 2022 4 p.m. | FREE

Franciscan Center of Lourdes University 6832 Convent Blvd., Sylvania

Between 1942 and 1944, more than 1.5 million Jews were massacred by mass shootings when Nazi Germany invaded the Soviet Union. Until recently, this chapter of Holocaust history, referred to as the "Holocaust by Bullets," was relatively unknown. During his lecture, Father Desbois will review the findings of his decade-long investigation of the war crimes committed by Nazi death squads in Eastern Europe during the "Holocaust by Bullets."

Roman Catholic Priest, Holocaust Researcher, and Human Rights Advocate

Father Patrick Desbois, founder of the international human rights organization Yahad-In Unum, is a prolific author, a distinguished Professor at Georgetown University, historian, forensic detective, and world-renowned human-rights activist. He has devoted his life to confronting anti-Semitism and furthering Catholic-Jewish understanding. Since 2001, he has led a truly historic undertaking of identifying and locating undiscovered mass graves of Jews murdered during the Holocaust in Eastern Europe.

His book, The Holocaust by Bullets, documents this work and is the winner of the 2008 National Jewish Book Award. The book will be available for sale at the lecture and at Barnes and Noble.
