FROM THE RABBI

Elul—Religious Warm-up Exercises

Elul is one of the months on the Jewish calendar which contains no days of special Torah-ordained significance other than Shabbat and Rosh Chodesh. Unlike Cheshvan or Iyar, however, the Shulchan Aruch (Code of Jewish Law) does discuss special observances within this month.



On the first day of the month of Elul we begin reciting Psalm 27 at the conclusion of the morning and evening services. Also on that day we begin blowing the shofar every morning. In the Sephardic tradition Selichot (Special Penitential Prayers) are recited early in the morning beginning on Rosh Chodesh. In the Ashkenazic world we do not begin to say Selichot until approximately a week before Rosh Hashanah.

The Rabbis give us other guidance regarding our behavior during Elul. We are encouraged to be more careful with our prayers, more free with our charity, and more introspective about our past deeds. They refer to biblical passages to support each action.

All of the things we do during Elul are designed to get ourselves prepared for Rosh Hashanah. With the new year comes Hashem's judgment regarding all aspects of our lives. We pray that the verdict will be for good. We try to influence the decision by trying to show Hashem that we really want to do better. We build up for a month with good deeds so we can come before Him on Rosh Hashanah with our new track record in hand, hopeful that Hashem will see our sincerity and turn back any difficult decree.

May the month of Elul provide us with sufficient and meaningful time to draw ourselves closer to G-d.

BUILDING BRIDGES THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS...

Words cannot describe the beauty of my Israel experience.

I departed June 7th for my eight day teacher seminar. The programming far exceeded my expectations. Each day offered a new bridge to discover or build. The first day I met and connected with the other participants and lay leaders.

Tuesday, we visited The Jewish Resistance Fighters Museum, the Tunisian Synagogue, and an elementary school where the children were so excited to entertain us with singing and lively music. We also had a special musical workshop connecting instruments and music. Yaakov Friedman and his family spent the afternoon with our group. Yaakov spoke to the group during the evening telling his story.

I visited our twin school on Wednesday. It was a pleasure meeting the Principal and teacher, Adi and Anat. We discussed project plans for this school year. The students from both schools will introduce themselves to our students in September. This will bring even more excitement and meaning to our Ohr Chadash families!

A truly beautiful experience was our visit to a Druze village. Here we watched a celebration between Jews and the Druze. Dr. Janan Falach, the first Druze woman to receive a Ph. D spoke about the life in mixed neighborhoods and the challenges of coexistence. We concluded the afternoon with "Museum in a Luggage." This was a theatrical presentation on the Ethiopian Aliyah to Israel.

I spent the next three nights staying with my host family-Efrat Srebro. Efrat was the wonderful music educator who visited Toledo in the spring. Sharing Shabbat, stories, history and the scrumptious foods made the connection so very special.

Our last few days started with a trip to Tzfat and then onto Jerusalem. The experience was inspiring. Returning home, I have a stronger connection to and a greater appreciation for Israel.

I am so excited to plan our "twinning" project with Ohr Chadash and Eyal, A Regional Community School for Special Education. This is designed to educate our future generations. Connecting with the teachers here in the United States and in Israel will help the schools and Partnership grow stronger.

This year as part of the annual family picnic we are having a wonderful musical program preceding the food portion of the afternoon.

Beginning at 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, August 16th, facilitator Cassandra Bridinger, an artist and river flute player will be playing a cedar flute as well as drumming on found objects, driftwood from Hawaii and Lake Erie, as well as wood from the Cascade Mountains. Her artwork and music involves creating images and sounds that soothe the mind and heart. Several other percussionists will join her on the didgeridoo, congas, djembes, flutes, xylophones, tambourines, rattles, etc.



However, the most important element is YOU!

Come to experience the wonder of a drum circle to create the joyful sound of free form drumming, entirely improvised in-the-moment.

All ages are invited and no skill level or musical ability is necessary; just the desire to gather together and experience the universal language of rhythm through percussion, usually followed by bursts of delighted laughter!

Or come just to listen and enjoy!

If you have them, bring your own drums or acoustic musical instruments, found object noise makers, etc. to join in or to share with your friends! Practically anything that can be banged on to make noise can be used as a percussion instrument such as cans, buckets and pipes. There also will be a few extra drums to have fun drumming on.

Drum circles are one of America's fastest growing holistic health trends. They're inclusive, attracting people of all ages, spiritual beliefs and abilities. The drum circle offers equality because there is no head or tail, with the main objective to share rhythm with each other and to experience a personal expression unique to each individual.

Drumming induces deep relaxation, lowers blood pressure, and reduces stress. Stress, according to current medical research, contributes to nearly all disease and is a primary cause of such life-threatening illnesses as heart attacks, strokes, and immune system breakdowns. Group drumming tunes our biology, orchestrates our immunity, produces feelings of well-being and enables healing to begin.

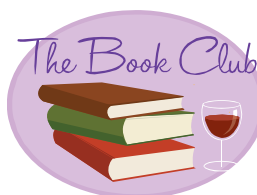
