FROM RABBI JASON MARK

This year, the beginning of the month of August is marked by a period of mourning- the “Nine Days”- which culminates with Tisha B'Av when we mourn the destruction of both Temples as well as more broadly all of the brokenness of our world.

However, on a very different note, just six days later lies the less known holiday of Tu B'Av (the 15th of Av). The Mishnah tells us that Tu B'av was amongst the happiest days of the year (second only to Yom Kippur!) and was celebrated as a matchmaking Holiday. On Tu B'av, women who struggled to get married, often due to lack of wealth, would be able to borrow beautiful white garments and go out into the fields where they would find their future spouses. This day was also the one day a year when Israelites were allowed to marry people from outside of their tribe. This opportunity to meet potential suitors free of all of the usual factors we judge others on—wealth, class, tribal-identity—was what made this matchmaking Holiday so joyous and special of an occasion.

I also think that the nature of the festivities of Tu B'Av has a deep connection to the brokenness of Tisha B'Av that precedes it. The Talmud teaches us that one of the main reasons the Second Temple was destroyed was because of baseless hatred between Jews. Though most Jews of that era were very observant and pious in their personal lives, different groups fought viciously over their small differences. They forgot to look for the image of G-D in others which led to the destruction of the Temple, G-D's physical Home on Earth. We can simply look at our own world, both Jewish and beyond, to see just how destructive this type of baseless hatred is.

While Tisha B'Av shows us all that is broken in our world, Tu B'Av illuminates a way forward through the darkness. If baseless hatred was our undoing, baseless love will be the source of our redemption. If we can truly love our fellow human beings and build a world where wealth, race and religion are not used as tools to divide and separate people, then we will merit once again to make this world into a suitable Home for the Divine. This is no small order! But it is our eternal task as Jews to always strive towards this ultimate goal.

TISHA B'AV

Tisha B'Av, the Fast of the Ninth of Av, is a day of mourning to commemorate the many tragedies that have befallen the Jewish people, many of which have occurred on the ninth of Av. Tisha B'Av means “the ninth (day) of Av”. This year it falls on Saturday evening/Sunday, August 6th & 7th, 2022.

Although this holiday is primarily meant to commemorate the destruction of the Temple, it is appropriate to consider on this day the many other tragedies of the Jewish people, many of which occurred on this day, most notably the expulsion of the Jews from Spain in 1492 and from England in 1290.

Tisha B'Av is the culmination of a three week period of increasing mourning, beginning with the fast of the 17th of Tammuz, which commemorates the first breach in the walls of Jerusalem, before the First Temple was destroyed. During this three week period, weddings and other parties are not permitted, and people refrain from cutting their hair. From the first to the ninth of Av, it is customary to refrain from eating meat or drinking wine (except on the Shabbat) and from wearing new clothing.

The restrictions on Tisha B'Av are similar to those on Yom Kippur: to refrain from eating and drinking (even water); washing, bathing, shaving or wearing cosmetics; wearing leather shoes; engaging in sexual relations; and studying Torah. Work in the ordinary sense of the work (rather than the Shabbat sense) is also restricted. People who are ill need not fast on this day. Many of the traditional mourning practices are observed: people refrain from smiles, laughter and idle conversation, and sit on low stools.

In the synagogue, the book of Lamentations is read and mourning prayers are recited. Tisha B'Av is never observed on Shabbat. If the 9th of Av falls on a Saturday, the fast is postponed until the 10th of Av.
