SHARON RAVIN

TO RECEIVE THE 2023 HARRY LEVINE SERVICE AWARD



Sharon Ravin, a native Toledoan, is the oldest of the 4 children of Kalman and Toby Aharoni. Along with her siblings Danny, Barbara, and Debbie, she was raised in a loving family that instilled the values of Torah. From an early age, Sharon witnessed these values being lived on a daily basis by her parents.

After graduating in a little over 3 years from The Ohio State University, Sharon taught in the Columbus Public Schools for 1 semester prior to returning to Toledo. The early years of her career were spent teaching 6th grade at DeVeaux Elementary School. It was during this period that she met Beryl, her very supportive husband of 54 years. She left teaching prior to the birth of their first son, Josh, who was joined by his brother Michael two and a half years later. Shortly after the boys were both attending public school, Sharon continued on her career path as the Coordinator of the Community Hebrew School for 15 years. Sharon then pursued master's level work at BGSU attaining accreditation as a special needs educator. Seventeen years later, at the age of 71, Sharon retired from Start High School, but still substitute teaches at the two Sylvania high schools.

Prior to joining Etz Chayim in 1981, the Ravins belonged to Congregation B'Nai Israel where Sharon taught Sunday School and was active in the Sisterhood and served on the Religious School Committee. Her volunteerism with Women's American ORT, which began in 1966, led to her serving as President of the Toledo Area Council which at that time had a membership of over 800 Toledo women; followed by chairing ORT's retail store The Second Act and serving on the District board. Sharon co-chaired the 1983 Community Yom Ha'atzmaut celebration honoring Israel's 35th birthday. In addition, Sharon is a life member of Hadassah, was a member of the Darlington House Auxiliary and Netay Etz Chayim, served on the Women's Board of the then Jewish Welfare Federation, represented the Community Relations Committee at Sylvania Schools' board meetings, and was on a number of committees for the Jewish Community Center. Upon retirement, Sharon became an active member of our shul's Sisterhood and served as the Donor chairman for 6 years. She is also currently a member of the Board and the Future Committee.

Her family has grown to include her fabulous daughter-in-law Rachel Levy Ravin and 4 unbelievably phenomenal grandchildren Chana Leah, Zev Kalman, Eliana Bracha, and Akiva Shmuel.

Sharon is deeply humbled and greatly honored to have her strong commitment to Jewish identity and continuity recognized as this year's recipient of the Harry Levine Service Award.
