

Etz Chayim Torah Finds A New Home

A synagogue flourishes because of its members and their love of Torah.

Last year, the newly organized Maui Jewish Ohana (family) made a request to Ed Finkel, Managing Director-Network of Independent Communities of the Jewish Federations of North America, to match them with a congregation that would be willing to gift them a Torah.



Steve Edelstein of the Jewish Community Legacy Project has been advising Congregation Etz Chayim on the process of downsizing and made the synagogue aware of this request. Etz Chayim's board of trustees enthusiastically chose to send one of our beloved Torahs to the Maui Jewish Ohana. Through the effort, coordinated by Sharon Ravin, Danny Becker oversaw the packaging of the Torah and he and Mel Siegel drove it to Chicago on December 7. From there, it would fly to Maui with the son of one of the Hawaiian congregants.

How fitting that on the same day that Danny and Mel were the *shomrim* and *shamashim*, the guardians and helpers of the Torah on the first leg of its journey, they would come home and with Jews from Toledo to Maui, light the Hanukkah *shamash* to begin the celebration of the holiday. And, how interesting that on that same day, we were all remembering the attack on Pearl Harbor, an attack on our democracy, just as Hanukkah ecalls an attack on the right of the Jewish people to exist.

A Hachnasat Sefer Torah ceremony, the welcoming of a Torah, was held in Maui on Sunday, January 21 with a number of Etz Chayim members attending through Zoom. Former Toledoan, Greg Rosenbaum, who has a winter home in Maui, represented Etz Chayim at the ceremony and spoke eloquently about his maternal grandparents taking him with them to services at Shaarey Zedeck, one of the three congregations that merged in 1974 to form Etz Chayim. The Etz Chayim Torah, the name that it will always be called in Maui, could well have been one of the Torahs that his grandfather carried and blessed.

A synagogue flourishes because of its members and their love of Torah. As The Etz Chayim Torah was carried around, the Maui congregants kissed it, wept tears of joy, and danced with it under a chuppah. Their children observed and learned. The tree of life was planted. Through the congregation, the roots will grow. And to and through the children, the branches of knowledge will spread the significance of this Torah, *I'dor v'dor*, for generations to come.

It is a tree of life for those who grasp it and all its paths are peace.
