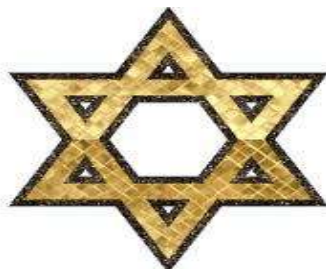

### **LAURA LEVENTHAL**

Laura Leventhal, a long-time resident of Bowling Green, is the oldest child of Donald and Zella Leventhal. She has one brother, D.B., who lives in Illinois. Her father was a Bowling Green State University psychology professor and her mother a psychiatric nurse. Growing up, her parents emphasized the importance of education and critical thinking, but also the importance of kindness. Her dad often said that it did not take any work to be nice to someone else.

Laura attended public schools in Bowling Green and started college at BGSU. She transferred to Georgia Tech, where she received a degree in Computer Science. She received her Ph.D. from The University of Michigan in Computer and Communication Sciences and taught at The University of Toledo during graduate school. She and her husband, Alan Jaffee, met and married during that time. Laura spent many years as a faculty member in the Computer Science Department at BGSU, retiring as a professor emeritus in 2011. Since her retirement, Laura has been teaching part-time at The University of Findlay.

Laura and Alan have two sons, Brian and Sam, and two grandchildren.

Laura and Alan have belonged to the Shul for many years and have participated in a number of different capacities. Most recently, Laura is continuing her second term as Executive Vice President for Finance. Laura is so honored to be selected as this year's recipient of the Harry Levine Service award. The members of the Shul have been an extended family and support system for her and her family. Thank you for this award!

### **CHARLES WITTENBERG**

Charles Wittenberg was born in 1947 in Evansville, Indiana, the second of three sons of Hy and Toby Wittenberg. The family moved to Toledo in the summer of 1963 when Charles was 16. Several months later he met Phyllis Forman on a blind date for a BBYO hayride. Over the years Charles and Phyllis's relationship grew, they married in 1969, and recently celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary. Phyllis and Charles have two children: Aaron, who is married to the former Stacie Winegarden, and daughter Laura, who lives in Connecticut. They have two grandchildren, Max, a freshman at Indiana University and Lucy, a junior in high school. Charles and Phyllis are proud to say that Aaron, Stacie, Laura, Max and Lucy are all graduates of Jewish Day Schools.

Charles graduated cum laude from the University of Toledo College of Law in 1973 and served as an Ohio Assistant Attorney General in Columbus for three years. Charles and Phyllis returned to Toledo and over the next 21 years Charles was an attorney in private practice. In 1989 he was elected to the Sylvania Schools Board of Education and re-elected in 1993. Charles served two terms as president of the School Board. He also served as a magistrate in the Toledo Municipal Court, hearing small claims and traffic cases. In 1996, Charles was elected Judge of the Lucas County Common Pleas Court and was re-elected in 2000. Charles did not run for re-election in 2006, and, instead, became a "visiting judge", being assigned by the Ohio Supreme Court to hear cases throughout the state. Charles fully retired in 2017.

Charles has also served on the Board of the Jewish Federation and presently sits on the Board of Hillel for Toledo and Bowling Green State Universities.

Charles has been continuously serving as a gabbai for Etz Chayim for over 40 years and will continue to be the shul's gabbai for the upcoming year. Moreover, during this time, Charles has held many leadership positions at Etz Chayim. He has been a long-standing member of the Board of Trustees. From 1986 to 1988, Charles served as President of the synagogue. He has also held the offices of Personnel Vice President, Financial Vice President and Secretary. Moreover, Charles was president of the Etz Chayim Men's Club and also served for two years as principal of the Sunday Religious School.

Charles is honored to receive the Harry Levine Service Award. Congregation Etz Chayim and its members are an integral part of his life, and he believes it to have been a privilege to serve the shul.
