## FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear Congregant,

G-d instructed Moses to tell the people that water was going to come from the rock. Moses struck the rock after saying, "Listen now, you rebels!" Moses was then told that he would not be able to enter the Promised Land with the people he had led there.

The following question was posed by Rabbi Shayna Zauzmer, of New York's Park Avenue Synagogue, in a sermon about parsha, Chukat, "Was the punishment fair? Did it fit the crime?"

Rabbi Zauzmer cited Maimonides, saying that the reason Moses was punished was because he disobeyed the orders of G-d, who told him to tell the people that water was going to come from the rock. Maimonides argues that Moses' sin was not merely striking the rock, but his display of anger and harshness toward the people. When Moses says, "Listen now, you rebels!" Maimonides interprets this outburst as a moral failing, especially for a leader of Moses' stature. Moses' anger gave the impression that G-d was angry, which was not the case. By misrepresenting G-d's attitude, Moses caused a Chilul Hashem, a desecration of G-d's name.

Was the punishment about anger management? Was it about not doing as G-d had commanded?

Rabbi Zauzmer continued with the explanation of Nachmanides, who lived some sixty years later than Maimonides. Nachmanides said that the reason the punishment fit the crime, the reason it was fair, is that Moses had an opportunity to praise the Lord, to point out to the people that this was a miracle that G-d was performing for us.

By striking the rock, the full magnitude of G-d's power, that He alone could bring forth water, was diminished in the eyes of the people. When Moses and Aaron struck the rock and said, "Listen now, you rebels!", they spoke as if the miracle was from them, not G-d. They failed to sanctify G-d, by implying personal power. The miracle was meant to elevate the people's faith, and this opportunity was lost.

Rashi agrees that the sin was striking instead of speaking to the rock, showing a lack of sanctification of G-d's name.

Moses and Aaron gave up an opportunity for sanctification of G-d's Name, Kiddush HaShem, for actions that bring honor and reverence to G-d and the Jewish people.

And, of course, that is where we come in. It is most unlikely that any of us are going to have a conversation with G-d, or to receive an order from Him. But all of us represent the Jewish people and we can do that with pride and with foresight, with thoughtfulness. If we wear our Judaism proudly while we perform acts of loving kindness, when we give tzedakah, when we reach out to help others and do what we can to help repair our broken and troubled world, we are showing honor to G-d's Name. That is *Kiddush Hashem*.

I don't pretend to be a Torah scholar on any level. I have no idea how many times this lesson is given to us in the Torah. I was simply moved by the sermon delivered by Rabbi Shayna Zauzmer. This lesson is simply a reminder of something we all know.

I appreciate the work that our Board of Trustees and our staff continue to do on our behalf and I look forward to seeing you all at our forthcoming picnic. (Details inside) Stay well and be safe.
